50% Tempranillo, 50% Prieto Picudo.

Wine Type

Young red wine.

Winemaking

The blend of these two varieties enhances the distinctive qualities of each. Prieto Picudo is a grape found exclusively in our region, with small, tightly packed bunches, producing wines of great character and expression. Tempranillo, Spain's most widely planted noble variety, yields smooth and highly fruity wines. Vinified separately, with short macerations and natural malolactic fermentations in our underground cellar, the result is a smooth, velvety wine.

Tasting Notes

Deep cherry red with violet hues.

Aromas characteristic of Prieto Picudo, with subtle toasted notes and a background of floral, red fruit and blackberry nuances.

On the palate it is very smooth and silky, with ripe tannins. A velvety finish leads to a lingering aftertaste with renewed fruity sensations
