Grape Varieties
100% Tempranillo.

Type of Wine
Red Crianza wine aged in French oak barrels.

Winemaking
Both malolactic fermentation and ageing are carried out for 30 days in French oak barrels.

The Horcajo vineyard, which gives this wine its name, is located at an altitude between 850 and 900 metres. Its location provides excellent conditions for vine cultivation thanks to its protection from frost, the heterogeneity of the terrain, and the fertility of its soils. All these factors result in a well-structured wine with rich aromatic profiles.

Tasting Notes
Deep, intense cherry-red colour. On the nose, it is intense and complex, with black fruit notes typical of Tempranillo, showing great nuance and evolving in the glass without losing freshness. On the palate, it is powerful yet approachable, with rounded tannins and a long, persistent finish.
